YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD in the field of narcolepsy

The European Narcolepsy Network (EU-NN) aims to facilitate clinical and scientific progress in the field of narcolepsy and other hypersomnia of central origin.

For the 15th European Narcolepsy Day to be held in Montpellier, France, on July 6 2024, the EU-NN will grant a "Young Investigator Award".

If you are an early carrier fellow (see definition below), member of the EUNN, and have published an article on narcolepsy or hypersomnolence of central origin between January 2023 and February 2024, in a key position (first or co-first), you are invited to apply for this award. Note that the young investigator prize can be obtained only once.

The award is a prize as well as an invitation to present the awarded scientific work at the 15th Narcolepsy Day in Montpellier (it includes accommodation and travel expenses for up to 300.00 €).

Evaluation will be performed by the scientific committee with the help of external experts if needed to avoid conflict of interests.

CALL FOR ABSTRACT

All attendees are invited to submit abstracts for participating to the three Symposia and/or the Poster Session.
